



## Printer Color Profile Instructions

Color profiles are data files that contain a description of how a particular paper, ink, and printer create all colors, shades, and densities. Using a profile will result in more accurate and consistent output.

**Paper:** San Gabriel SemiGloss Fiber

**Printer:** Epson 4000, 4800, 4880, 7600/9600, 7800/9800, 7880/9880, X900 Series

### Setting Recommendations

<b>Media Setting:</b>	Premium Semigloss Photo Paper (250)
<b>Print Quality:</b>	1440dpi or Best Photo
<b>Color Controls:</b>	Off No Color Adjustment
<b>Black Ink</b>	Photo Black

### Some Hints

Turn on your printer's Prevent Paper Abrasion feature when using heavy weight papers. Go to [www.redriverpaper.com/feed](http://www.redriverpaper.com/feed) for more information.

The name of the paper you are using will not be listed in the media setting drop down menu in the printer driver. That menu only has the names of manufacturer papers.

Do not use the printer driver's "Preview before printing feature". It can interrupt the color management process.
