KEY CONCEPT

You are about to install print templates into Lightroom

This involves moving the folder of Red River templates you just downloaded into a Lightroom system folder.

Once complete, Lightroom will “see” these templates and display them in the Print module.

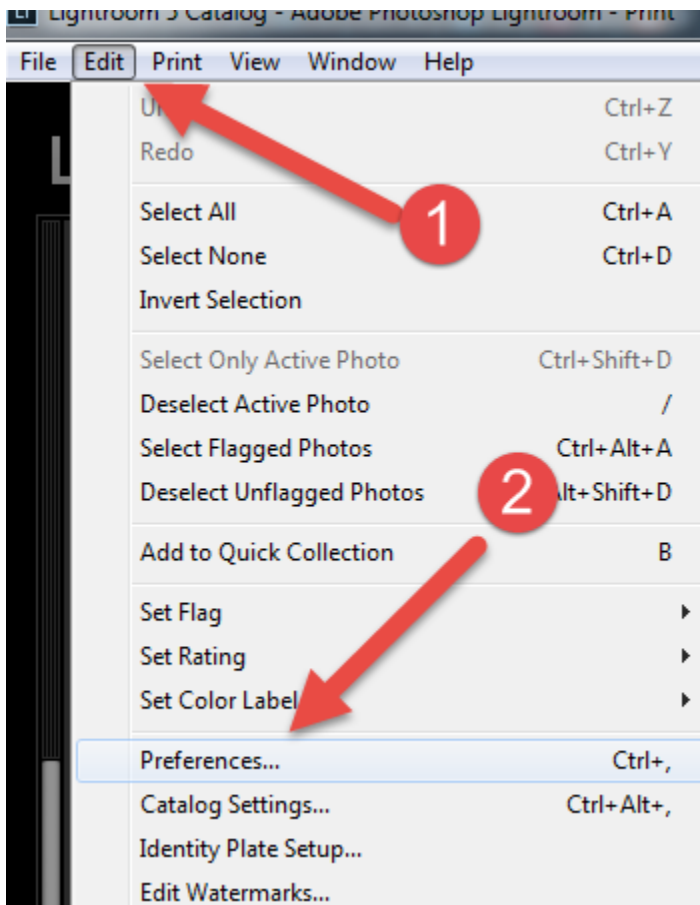
NOTE – This process requires basic knowledge of how to navigate your hard drive and use the copy and paste function. Follow these instructions precisely and you will be OK. If you are not comfortable with the process, find a local resource that is computer savvy and can assist.

WINDOWS INSTRUCTIONS

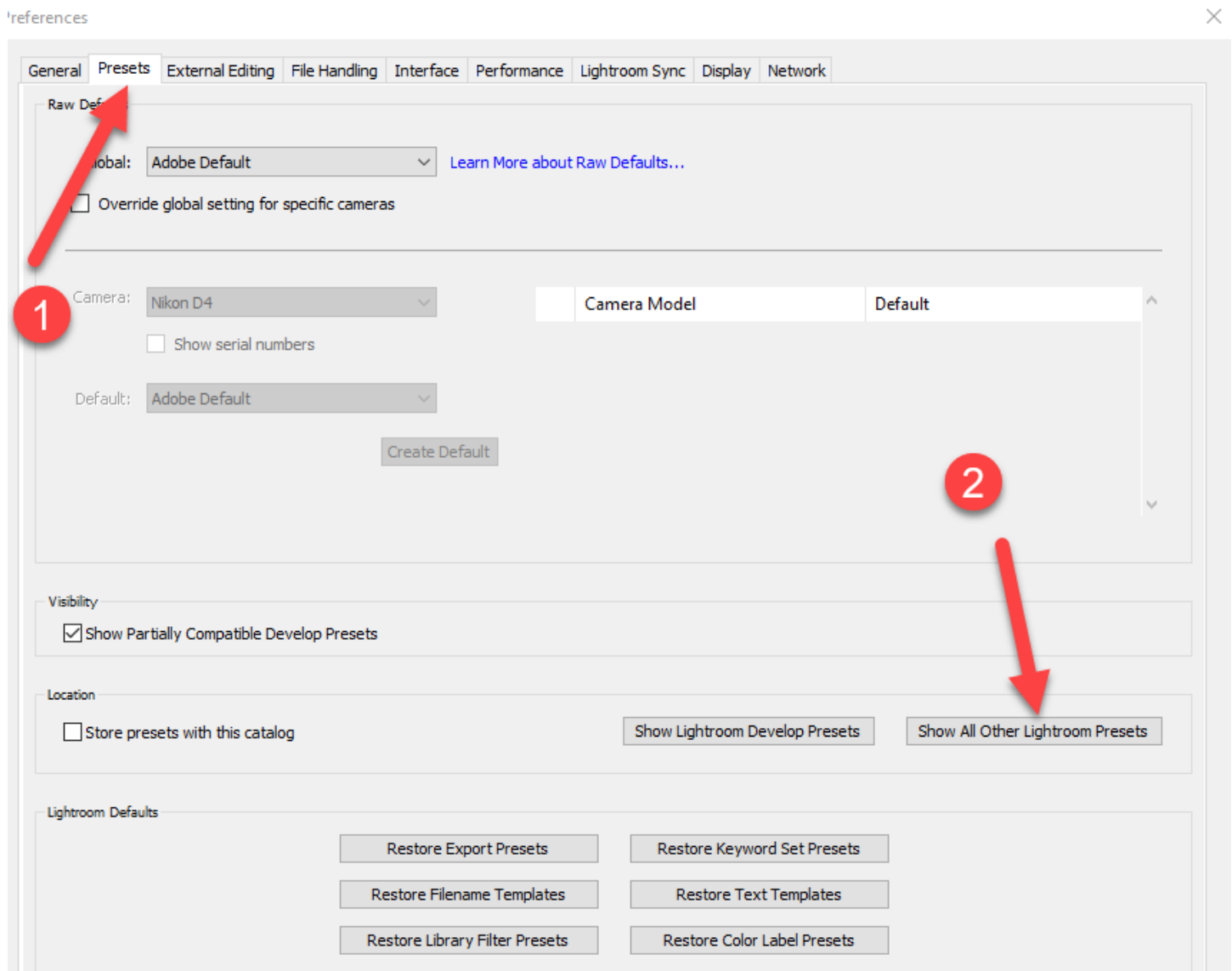
To determine where to copy the template folder, open Lightroom.

1 - Go to the Edit menu then click Preferences.



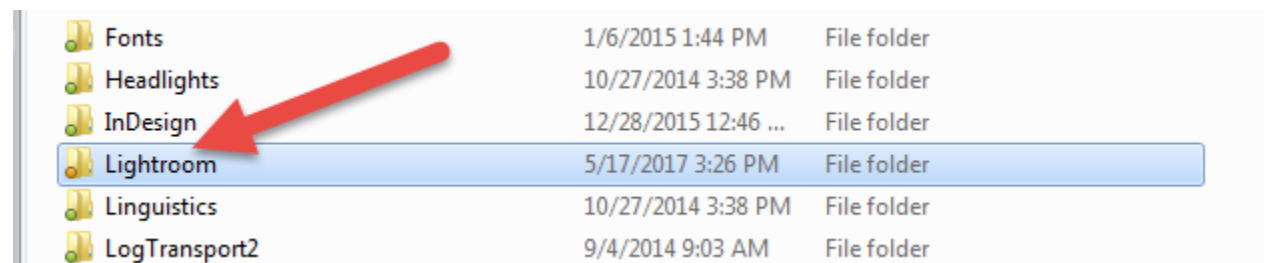
2. Click on the “Presets” tab

Under Location, click “Show All Other Lightroom Presets”



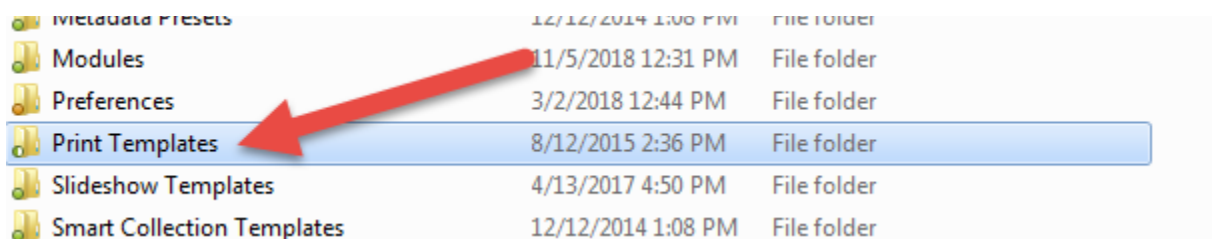
3. This will open the folder in your file browser. Double-click on the Lightroom folder.

DOUBLE CLICK to open the **Lightroom** folder



Find the folder labeled Print Templates and double-click to look inside that folder.

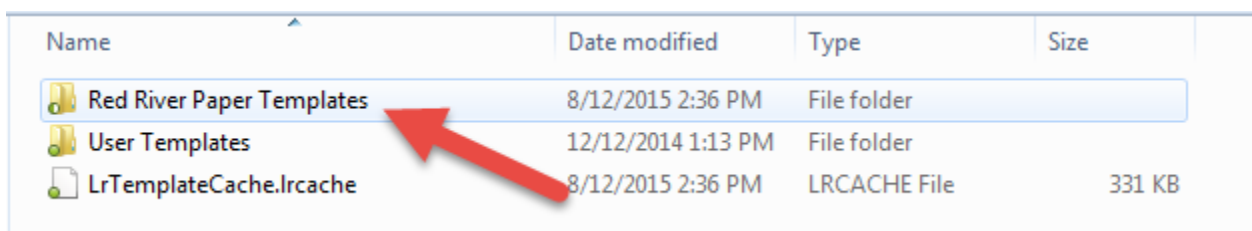
DOUBLE CLICK to open the **Print Templates** folder

4. Move the **ENTIRE** Red River Paper Templates folder (***not just the contents***) into the Print Templates folder.

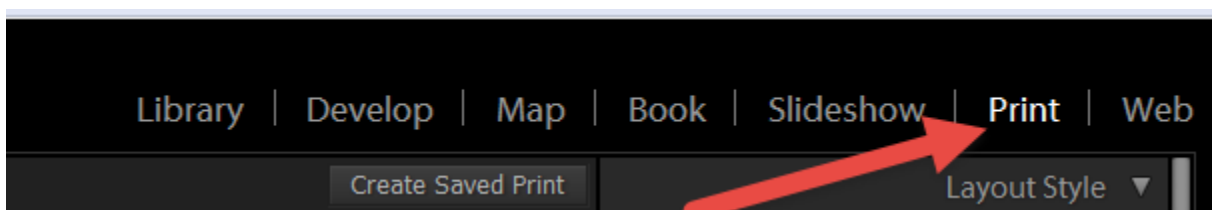
When you are done, the “Red River Paper Templates” folder will now be inside the Print Templates folder, as shown below.

5. Close and restart Lightroom.

6. Go to the Print module:



7. Locate the TEMPLATE BROWSER on the left side of the screen.

You will see the Red River Paper Templates as a subcategory.

Click the small triangle to the left of the section to reveal the templates.

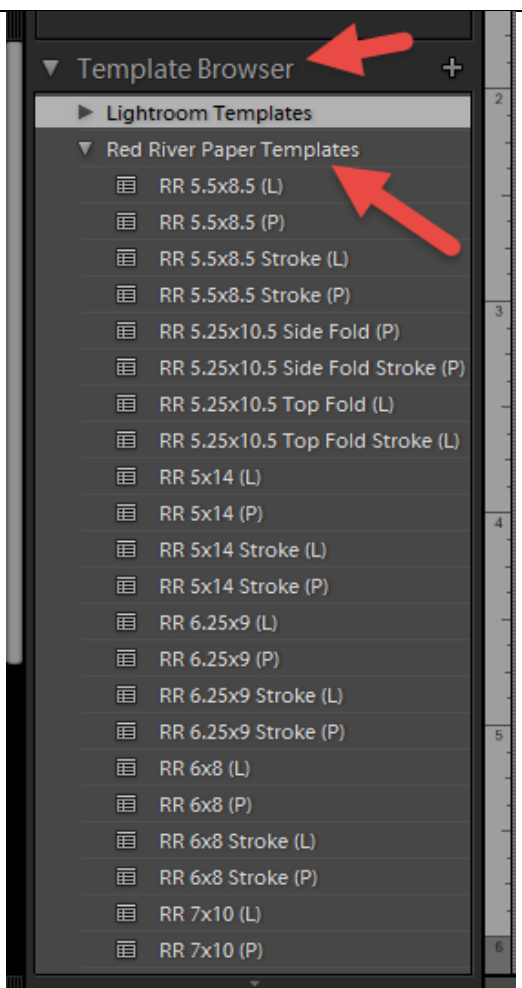
TROUBLESHOOTING

If you do not see the templates:

Did you restart Lightroom? If not, do so.

Go through the instructions again.

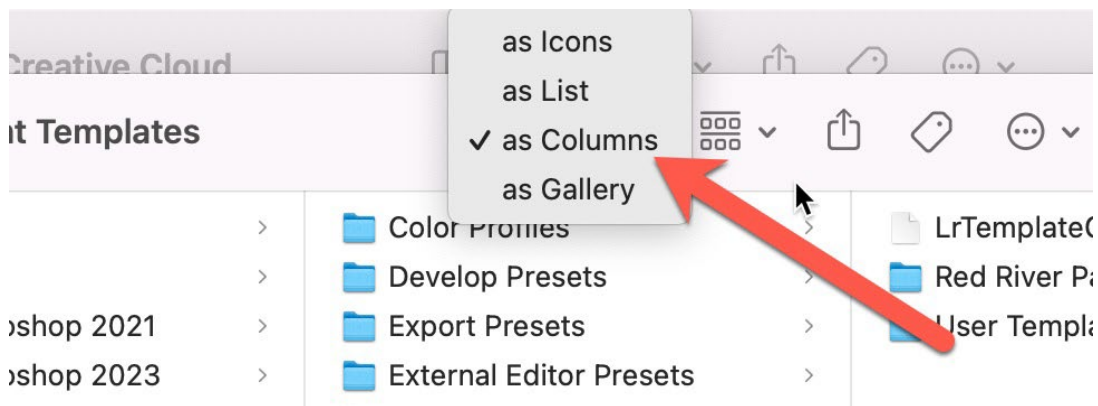
Confirm you moved the **ENTIRE FOLDER** of templates into the Print Templates folder.



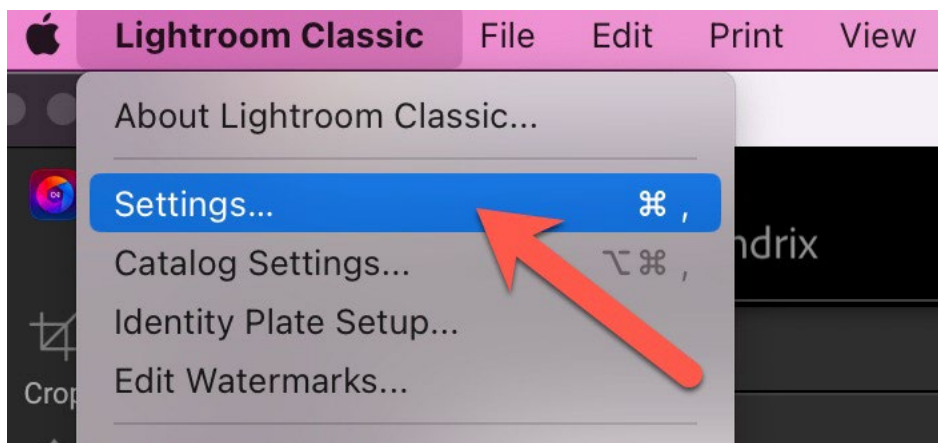
MAC INSTRUCTIONS

FINDER RECOMMENDATION

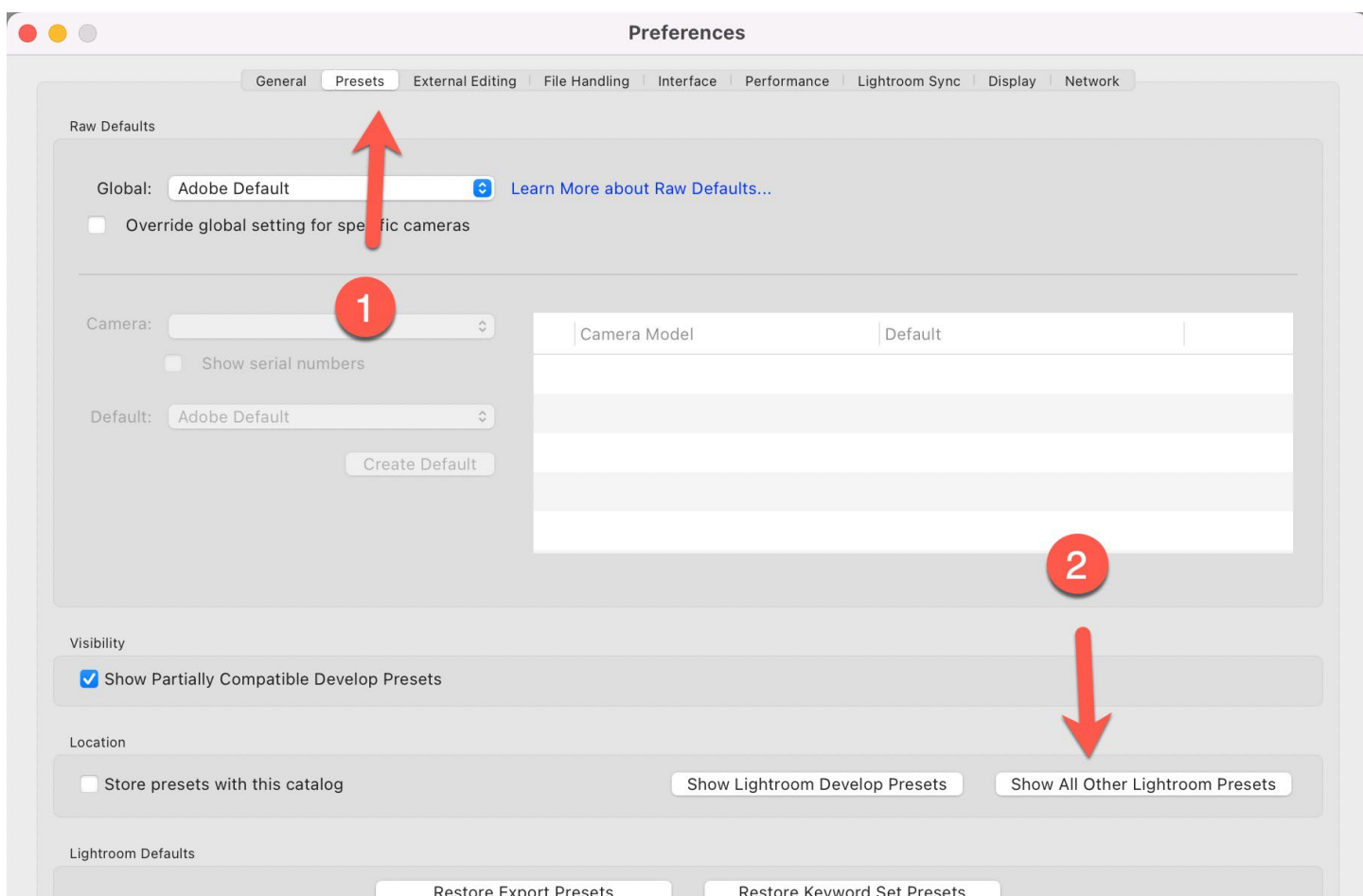
View the finder in COLUMNS mode.



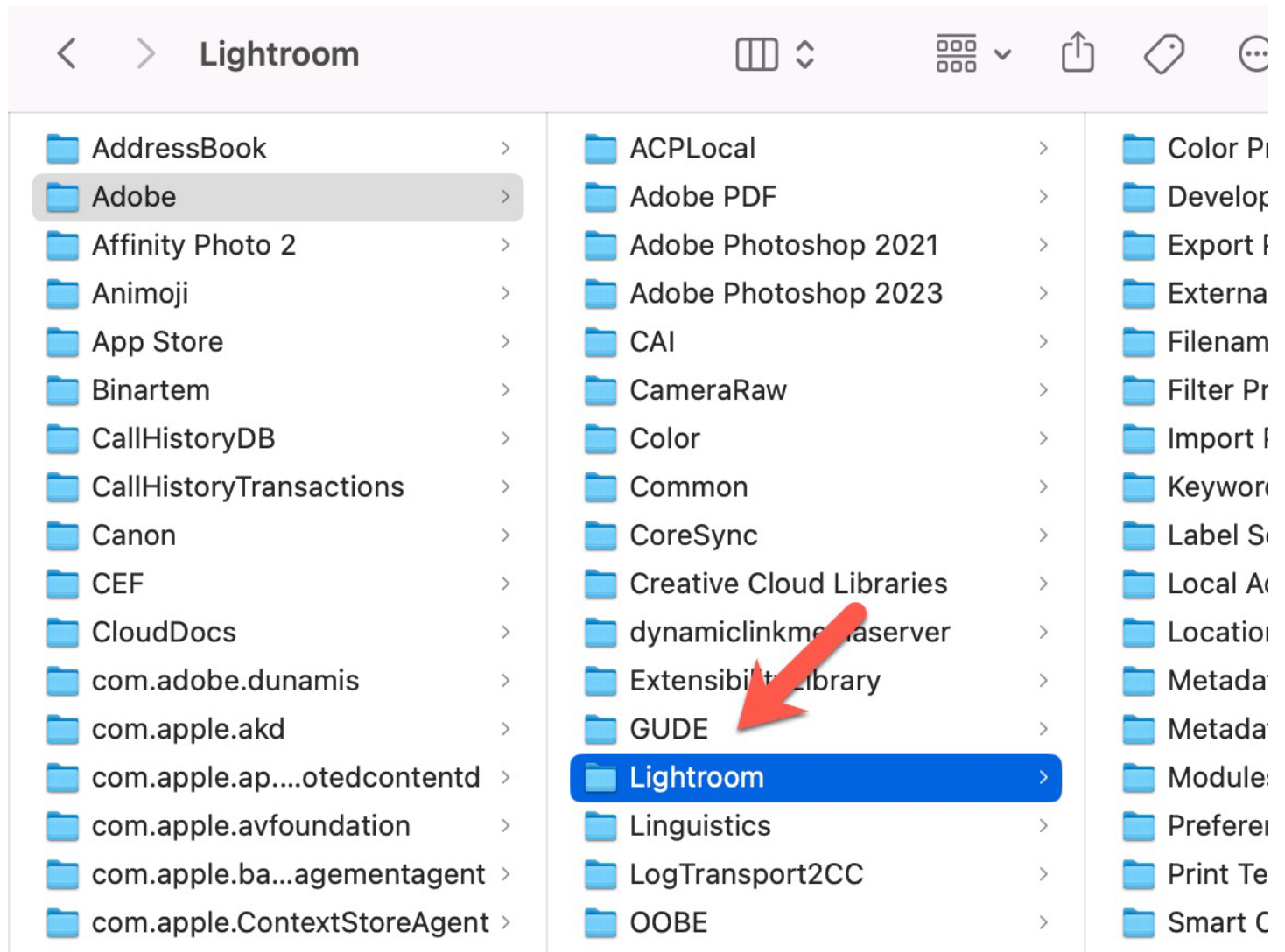
1. Mac – Go to the “Lightroom” menu and choose SETTINGS.



2. Click on the Presets tab and then click “Show All Other Lightroom Presets”



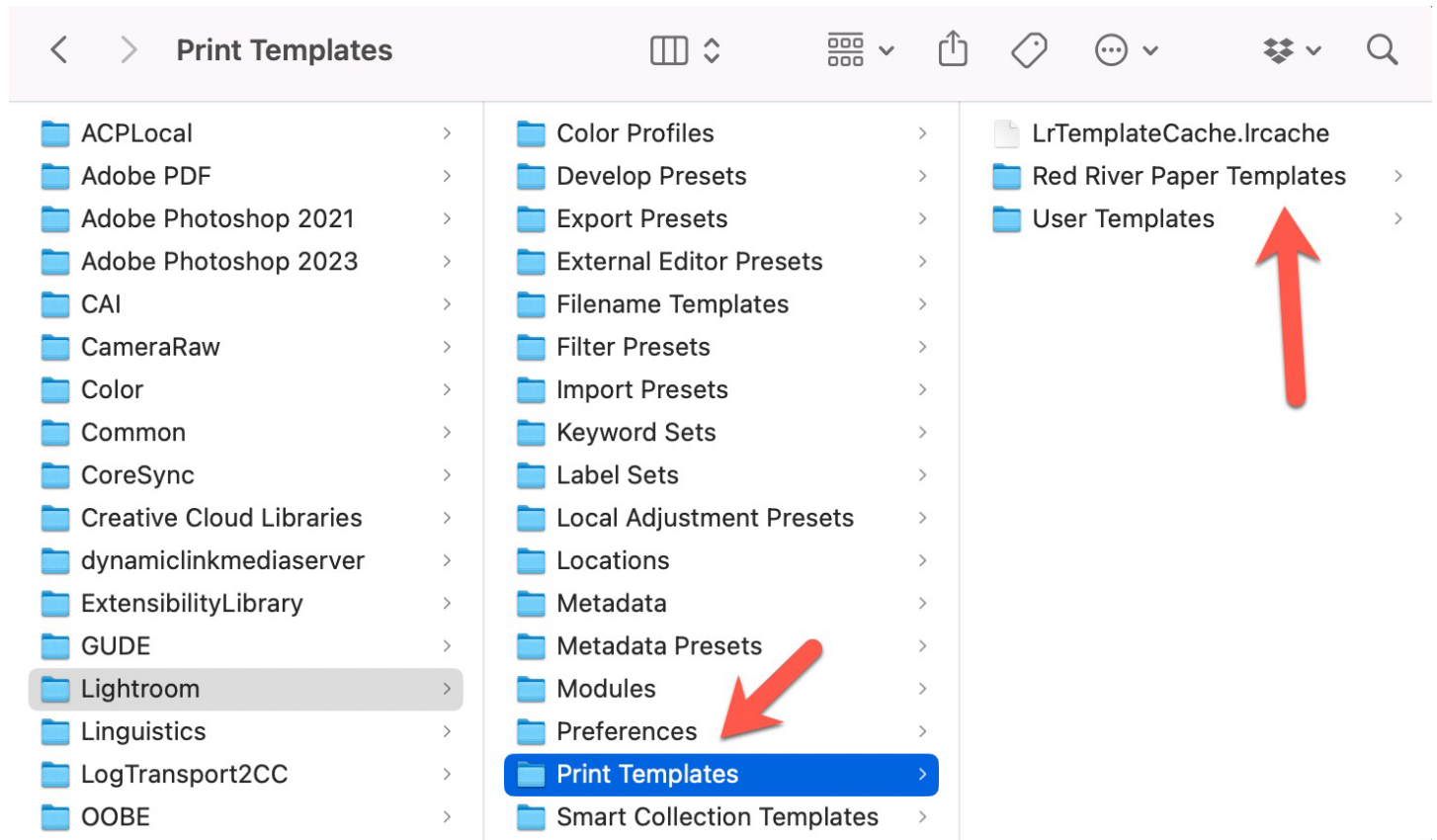
3. A finder window will open with the Lightroom folder highlighted.



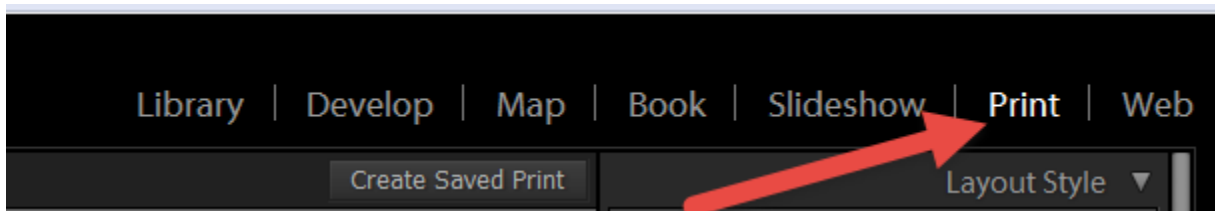
4. Locate the folder labeled Print Templates and click to look inside that folder.

Move the **entire** Red River Paper Templates folder (not just the contents) into the Print Templates folder. This can be copy and paste or drag and drop, your preference.

The point is that the **entire folder not just the contents** - you got from our download needs to be moved into the Print Templates folder.



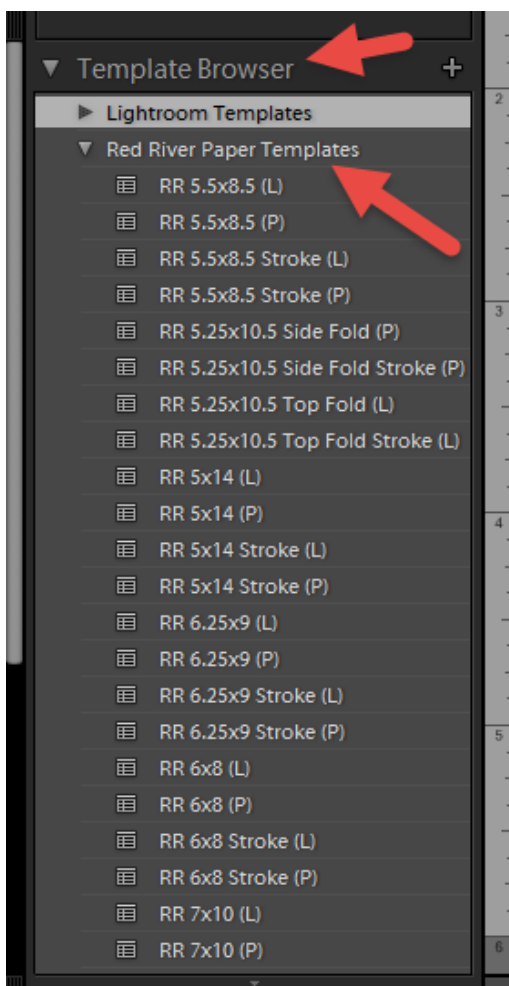
7. Now when you go to the Print module:



8. Locate the TEMPLATE BROWSER on the left side of the screen.

You will see the Red River Paper Templates as a subcategory.

Click the small triangle to the left of the section to reveal the templates.

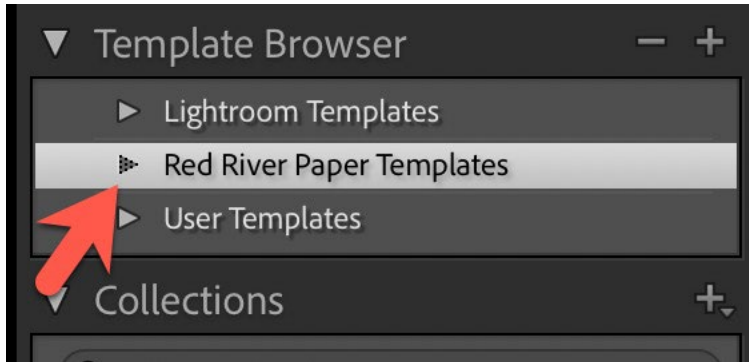


TROUBLESHOOTING

Don't see the templates in the template browser?

Did you restart Lightroom? If not, do so.

Look carefully – They appear in a sub-directory of the Template Browser. You have to click the small triangle to the left of the title to see them:



Still not there?

Go through the instructions again and triple check you moved the **ENTIRE FOLDER** of templates into the Print Templates folder.
