Some Hints

 The name of the paper you are using will not be listed in the media setting drop down menu in the printer driver. That menu only has the names of manufacturer papers.

Do not use the printer driver's "Preview before printing feature". It can interrupt the color management process.

Turn on your printer's thick paper setting when using heavy weight papers.

- Canon Printers – activate the "Prevent Paper Abrasion" setting
